DANGER

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: PC-991 can be applied by spray or drip method.

Spray method: Spray onto clean trolleys and hooks for lubrication and rust protection. Blow off excess oil or let drip for sufficient amount of time to avoid dripping onto meat products.

Dip method: Float ¼-3 inches of oil on top of hot water (160-180°F). Dip clean trolleys and hooks in oil to completely cover them with oil. Blow off excess oil or let drip for sufficient amount of time to avoid dripping onto meat products.

Additional Precautions: Avoid water contamination and extreme temperature to minimize product degradation.
